## Mineral Haiku

Grades: K-8

<u>Time</u>: 1/2 to 1 hour

## Objectives:

To practice close observation of a mineral by drawing it; to learn what products are made from that mineral; to practice use of creative language arts, and drawing.

## Materials:

- Minerals from your mineral box
- Pens, pencils, crayons, colored pencils, markers
- Colored or white 8.5 x 11 paper

## Procedure:

- 1. On the top of your paper write the name of the mineral you have chosen.
- 2. Underneath, draw and color a picture of the mineral leaving at least 3 inches at the bottom.
- At the bottom of your page, write a haiku\* that relates to the mineral you have chosen. Try to think about specific aspects of the mineral that makes it different from other minerals.
- 4. On the back of the paper, list products that use the mineral you have chosen.
- 5. Read your Haiku to the group.
- \* Haiku is a poem in three lines, with line of 5, 7 and 5 syllables respectively. For example, for the mineral quartz:

Quartz. White, clear, colors. So pretty and so useful Find it everywhere
